

# TXRF2025 ABSTRACT PREPARATION GUIDELINES

## (RESTRICT TITLE TO TWO LINES)

Abstract should be written in English. It should be strictly limited to one A4 (210 x 297 mm) page without the page number, and leaving a space of 20 mm at top and 25 mm at left, right and bottom edges. It must be submitted in PDF format. The maximum file size is 5 MB.

The abstract must begin with the title followed by the names of the authors and the addresses of their institutions. The title, authors and addresses should be centered on the page. Use only initial letters for first name. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Use the „*writeto*” command to indicate the email address of the presenting author. An example of use this command is included in the source (tex) file.

The font used should be Times 11-point, except for the abstract title which should be in Times 14-point bold capital, Times 11-point bold for authors and Times 10-point for addresses, figure caption, references and footnote. The lines should be single-spaced and justified.

To insert a picture, use the „*insertpicture*” macro. The macro requires two parameters: file name and picture description. An example of use this macro is included the source (tex) file. A picture will be shown in color in the electronic version of the abstract. If you submit a color figure it is your responsibility to ensure that it is easy to read and to be understood even in grayscale mode. Pictures should be submitted as a separate file.

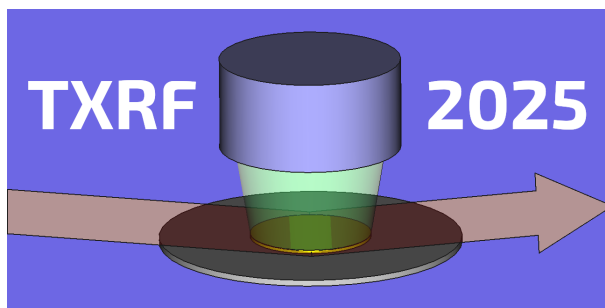


Figure 1: Official logo of the 20th International Conference on Total Reflection X-ray Fluorescence Analysis and Related Methods (TXRF2025).

References in the text must be numbered and enclosed in square brackets, for example [1, 2]. The list of references should be placed at the end of the abstract.

It is your responsibility to check that the abstract is correctly formatted and readable. Incorrectly formatted abstracts will have to be corrected. **Do not modify the predefined margins and macros.**
